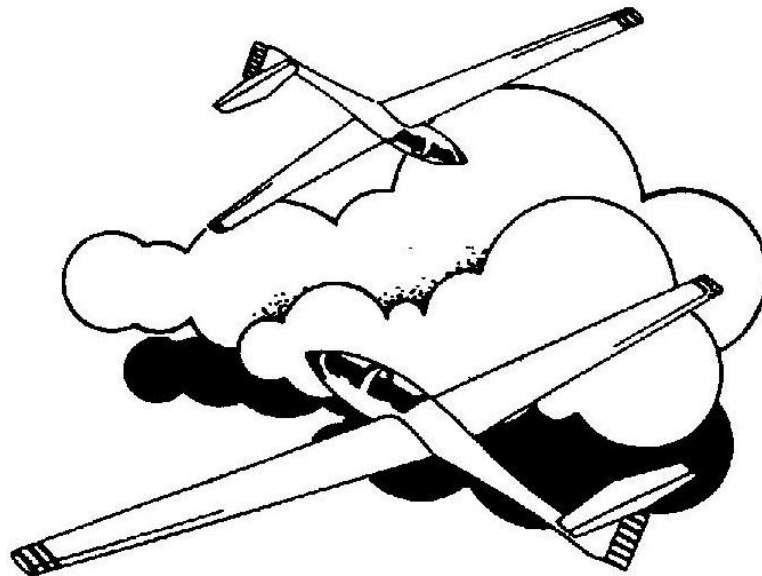

Invitation to Nordic Glider Aerobatic Championships 2011

The Norwegian Airsports Federation has the pleasure of inviting you to participate in the **Nordic Glider Aerobatic Championships 2011**, which will take place in Elverum, Norway from July 14th to 17th 2011.

The Championship also includes the **Norwegian Open Glider Aerobatic Championship 2011**.

We would like to see at least one grading judge from each of the competing countries. Nominees to be put forward before June 25th to the organizer.

Judges must have completed theoretical course in the regular interpretation of aerobatic flying to be qualified to judge.

Gliders:

Contestants may use their own glider of any type.

The glider must be airworthy, approved for the intended manoeuvres by its handbook and have a valid third part insurance according insurance regulations.

The following minimum aircraft equipment is required:

- Parachute with packing certificate
- First aid kit
- Aircraft Documents
- Radio
- G-Meter

Several contestants may use the same aircraft, which can lead to competition management must adjust the starting order in the contest. Competition Management reserves the right to inspect glider, mounting of devices, parachutes, documentation, and general condition and if necessary disallow the use of defective equipment during the competition.

ASK 21 gliders available on site for contest and for training. Glider rent NOK 180 / start training and competition flying

Pilots:

Competitors shall have

- a valid national glider certificate
- a sporting license
- national approval for aerobatic flight, if applicable.

To qualify as NGAC 2011 there must be participants from at least 2 Nordic countries and the total number of participants must exceed 5 in each categories

Safety pilot: The safety pilot is available free of charge by the contest organization.

Categories: IAC Sportsman and Advanced

Competition Flight Program A complete contest will consist of the competition flight programs shown in table below.

Known Sportsman – appendix 1, IAC Sportsman
Known Advanced – appendix 2, FAI Advanced
Free Advanced – to be forwarded to chief judge before July 5th (forward by e-mail snlf@nlf.no)
Unknown Advanced – to be published 24 hours before flying.

Minimum height Sportsman 400m and Advanced 200m (QFE)

Rules: Nordic and Norwegian glider aerobatic championships will take place according to IAC's "Official Contest Rules" or FAI sporting code depending on competition class.

Cancelation of contest: If unforeseen circumstances beyond of control would appear that prevent the competition implementation, the organizer reserves the right to cancel the competition.

The organizer also has the right to suspend the contest if the number of participants would be abnormally low. In such cases the contestants will be announced as soon as possible. Fees already paid to the organisation will be repaid.
